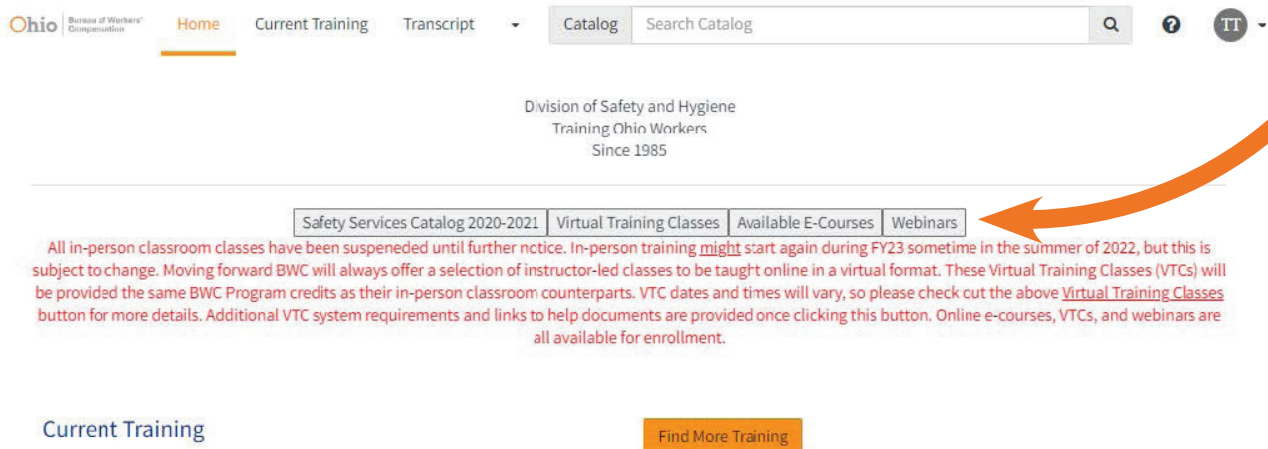


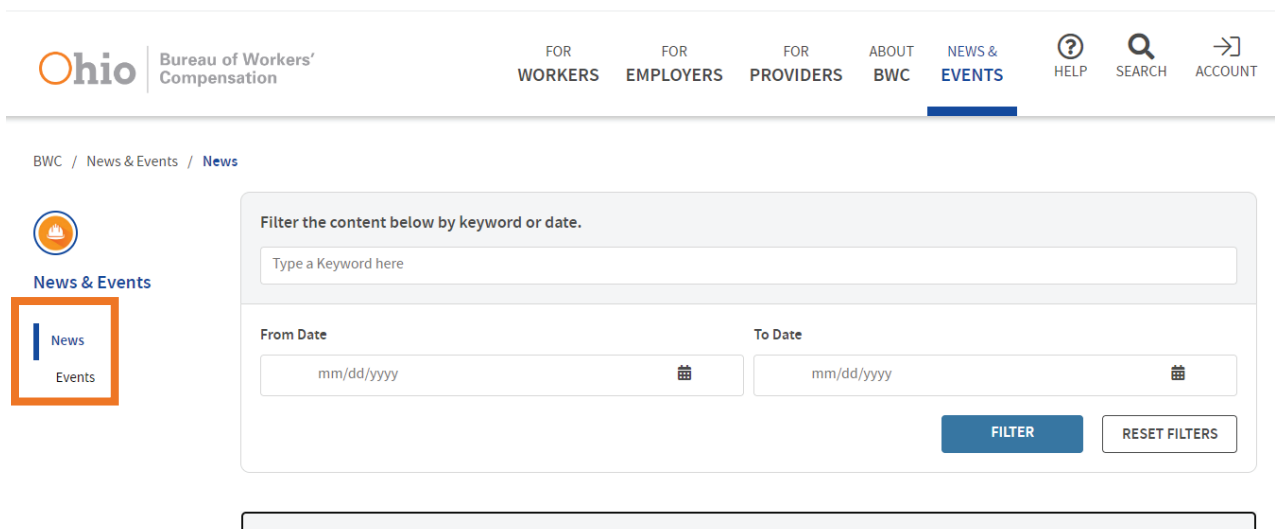
How to Register for a BWC Safety Webinar

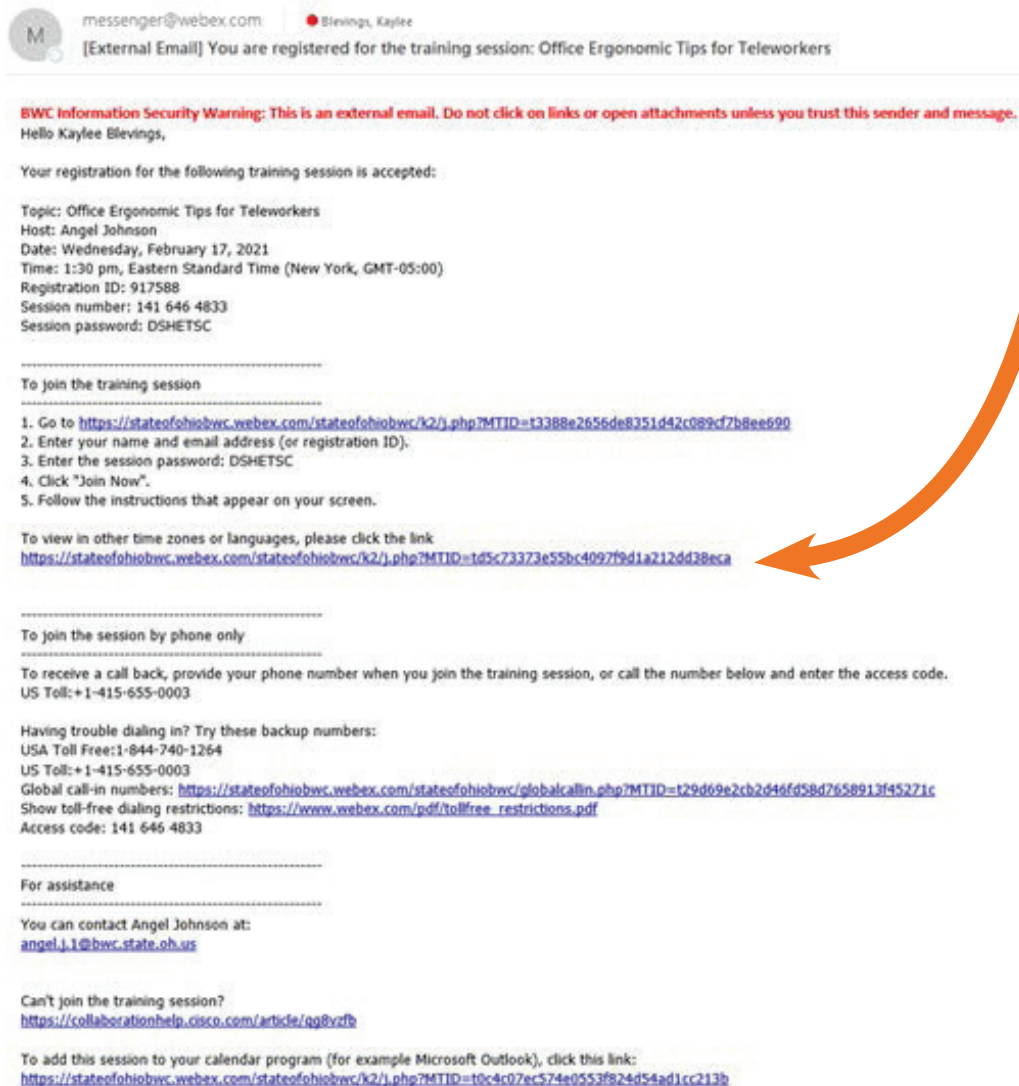
