This Excavation Competent Person event provides a general overview in identifying hazards, evaluating working conditions, and making decisions. It will **NOT** replace an employer's responsibility to designate, educate, and oversee their organization's "Competent Persons."

This 6-hour Competent Person Training Will Cover:

- Definitions used in the OSHA Excavation Standards (1926 Subpart P) and requirements (OSHA, ANSI, etc.) for being a Competent Person on an excavation site
- Safety-related requirements, considerations and elements of planning an excavation
- General and unique hazards associated with trenching and excavation work, and related countermeasures
- Soil Testing and Classification System (per appendix A of the OSHA excavation standard)
- Selection of and requirements for protective systems
